Challenge Four: Toy Making Challenge

Slum Survivors must make and sell their own toys or crafts.

This is reality:

Not only will children make toys and craft for their own use out of scrap materials, but often families will try to make items that they can sell to tourists.

Material required:

- Slum rupees
- Wire
- Milk cartons
- Egg cartons
- String
- Bottle caps
- Sticks
- Pliers
- Scissors

Process:

1) Families are given a time limit to make toys, jewellery or other craft items for sale.

2) "Tourists" visit the slum area and may buy items. (You will need several assistants to play these roles). They should pay 20 rupees for high quality items, 10 rupees for so-so items and 5 rupees or less for poor quality items. They should refuse to buy items where it is clear that no effort has been made.

It may help the simulation if the tourists are haughty and disdainful, and express disgust at the condition of the slum.

3) The proceeds from this challenge can be used to buy the families' food rations, or the family that earns the most money from this challenge can win a prize.
